### 211 Maryland at United Way of Central Maryland (FY24):

- **8,512** calls answered
- **Top needs:** Housing, Utility Assistance, Food Assistance



### Family Stability Program

(Since inception through mid-year FY24):

- **353** families served, including **748** school-age children
- **99.7%** of school-age children avoided a disruptive school transfer
- **99.7%** of families remained housed during program
- **97.0%** of program exits were successful



### Neighbors United (FY24 through Q3):



- **14** core team members recruited by community partners
- **100%** of core team members live in the neighborhood
