Strategic Targeted Eviction Prevention (STEP) Program (FY24):

- 1,166 individual program beneficiaries
- \$4.49M distributed to prevent eviction



Housing Emergency Assistance Program (FY24 mid-year):



- 24 individuals served in 10 households
- \$25,500+ distributed for emergency assistance





Impact in Baltimore County



Family Stability Program

(Cumulative from program inception through mid-year FY24):

- Since inception, 585 families served, including 1,069 school-age children
- 100% of school-age children have avoided a disruptive school transfer
- 98% of families remained housed during program
- 93.8% of program exits were successful



Grants Invested:

- 18 total grants
- \$169,952 invested
