## Impact in Harford County

### Project Connect:



- **450** guests served
- **135** free laptops distributed
- **57** haircuts provided
- **250** boxes of produce distributed
- **100** dental exams completed
- **104** eye exams completed with **87** eyeglasses prescribed



### 211 Maryland at United Way of Central Maryland (FY24):

- **3,878** calls answered
- **Top needs:** Housing, Utility Assistance, Legal Assistance



### Housing:

#### Strategic Targeted Eviction Prevention (STEP) Program (FY24):



- **52** individuals from **16** households avoided eviction
- **\$129K** distributed to prevent eviction

#### Family Stability Program:

- Since inception **182** families served, including **350** school-age children
- **96.7%** of families remained housed during program
- **99.7%** of school-age children have avoided a disruptive school transfer
- **91.6%** of program exits were successful
